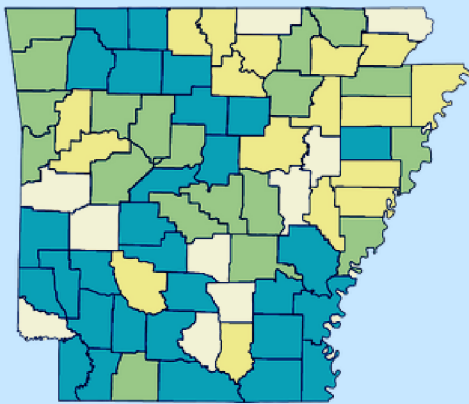
- ★ **Nonprofit community programs are a vital part of the state's economic engine**

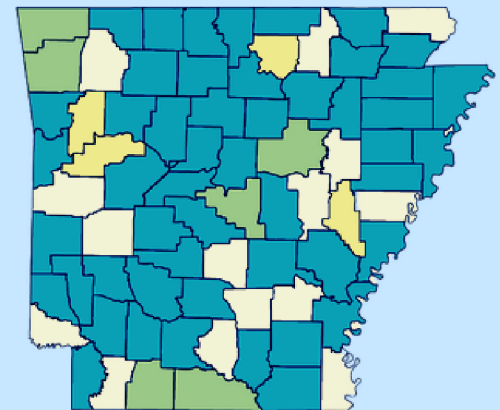


EIDT (Early Intervention Day Treatment)

-  DDPA member organization(s) only that provide EIDT services
-  Non-DDPA member(s) provide EIDT services
-  Both DDPA & non-DDPA organizations provide EIDT services
-  Counties which do not have EIDT services (unless they travel to a neighbor county)

ADDT (Adult Development Day Treatment)

-  DDPA member organization(s) only that provide ADDT services
-  Non-DDPA member(s) provide ADDT services
-  Both DDPA & non-DDPA organizations provide ADDT services
-  Counties which do not have ADDT services (unless they travel to a neighbor county)



Home and Community-Based Services



DDPA member organizations provide Home & Community-Based Services (HCBS), often referred to as Medicaid Waiver services, in all seventy-five (75) counties.
